

## FUTURE NFCA GENDER EQUITY INITIATIVES:

Although cost will always be part of the process, the NFCA would welcome a better understanding of how sponsorship revenue is sought and used in NCAA championships, especially women's championships, and specifically, softball.

This will allow a direct path for advancement for softball and baseball. It's time to make this happen.

<u>Championship Committee Composition.</u> NCAA Softball Championships Committee members are charged with making impactful decisions including but not limited to, selection of the participating teams and seeding the tournament brackets. Although not currently a requirement, the NFCA would recommend as a prerequisite at a minimum that NCAA Softball Championships Committee members have an understanding of our sport and a deep-seated investment in its future.
