



NFCA Virtual Convention Policies

December 9-11, 2020

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1. NFCA Virtual Convention Overview: Whether you are a first-year coach wondering about pitching and practice planning, or a seasoned veteran who needs new drills and an updated hitting philosophy, the NFCA has you covered. The NFCA Convention is the “must attend” annual gathering of NFCA members and exhibitors who serve the softball community. While COVID-19 has placed restrictions on gathering in-person this year, the NFCA has shifted the planning for this event and adapted it for a virtual platform. This virtual platform will allow you to enhance your coaching portfolio from your own work or home space, making it accessible to more coaches by eliminating the costs of travel and accommodations.

2. NFCA Virtual Convention Expectations: Attendees shall conduct themselves in a responsible and professional manner at all times. Disorderly or offensive conduct will not be tolerated. Individuals who engage in any such acts may be removed from sessions and/or may have their virtual access revoked with no refunds.

3. Registration

3.1 Timeline: Online registration for the NFCA Virtual Convention opened on September 8 and will remain open until Friday, December 11, 2020 at noon ET. “Early Bird” rates for NFCA Members and Non-NFCA Members are available through November 16.

3.2 Registration/Access Policy: Each registration shall provide online access for one attendee. Content from the online convention will be available to all registrants for 30 days after the convention concludes. Registrants may elect to upgrade their online access to lifetime, on-demand for an additional fee. The sharing of codes, links, or other ways to access Convention sessions is prohibited. Registration is non-transferrable and non-assignable. This policy is consistent with the in-person Convention credential policy.

3.3 Eligibility: Prospects, as defined by the NCAA, are not eligible to register for the Convention.
